dominated by rice, which relies heavily on groundwater or irrigation — could result in a loss of about 13-43 cubic kilometres of groundwater if warming of the planet continues, a team of researchers, including those from the Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar, said.

The researchers proposed shifting from existing cropping habit by cutting down on cultivating rice as a potential solution for sutaining the fast-depleting resource in a warmer world that threaens food and water security.

"Replacing 37% area of rice with other crops can recover 61 to 108 tubic kilometres groundwater compared to 13 to 43 cubic kibmetres with current cropping pattern under the 1.5-3 degræs Celsius global warming levels," the authors wrote in the study accepted for publication in the journal Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences (PNAS) Nexus. Compared to current cropping trends, the benefits of switching crops in saving groundwater are more during the prolonged dry periods predicted under global warming, the researchers said.

According to the 2018 Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change' (IPCC's) Special Report: Global Warming of 1.5 degrees Celsius, f current trends continue, global warming is likely to reach 1. degrees Celsius between 2030 and 2050 and could reach 3 degrees Celsius by 2100.

Changing crp patterns can be substantially eneficial — particularly for the sates of Punjab, Haryana, and Utir Pradesh — for ensuring grounwater sustainability and farmes' profitability, the authors said

They also foud that switching of crops did bt substantially impact groun water levels where recoveryates were low such as in the stæs of Himachal Pradesh, Uttaakhand, and Jharkhand.

The findings ave policy implications for iderifying optimal cropping pattern for sustaining groundwater in the irrigated regions of north India, along with ensuring farmer' profitability and income, they aid.
